#### Synopsis:

The Enforcement Officers were directed to concentrate on roads that have previously been identified as on the "Top Ten" list. They have been identified above by an \*. Four roads have shown an increase and two have shown a reduction and one remained the same. It should be noted that the Enforcement Team was reassigned for one entire week due to safety issues involving Greenwich High School.

Focus will remain in the month of March on E. Putnam And W. Putnam Avenues as they are recognized to have a large number of collisions and have not shown a reduction. Greenwich Ave. will also be addressed again however the nature of Greenwich Ave. and the collisions that occur there are not necessarily corrected by Enforcement efforts.

The speed trailers were kept inside for the majority of the month of February due to multiple snowstorms.
